

Answers to Sample Questions

Check your answers with the following answer sheet and mark the bottom of your paper with your results.

Although this may be a good indication of the type of test you will undertake in the entrance evaluation, it must be understood that the actual test is more comprehensive and will consist of a greater number of questions.

To successfully pass the entrance evaluation, you must demonstrate a good knowledge of each component within the test, including literacy, numeracy and reasoning skills. If an applicant fails to demonstrate the required skills in any one of these areas, they will not be credited with a pass, regardless of how well they performed in the remaining areas.

A score of 16 correct answers spread evenly across the sample questions is an encouraging result, although not a sole factor. Consideration should be given to the competitive nature of the selection process and that higher results increase opportunities for selection.

If your result is below or around 16, it is highly recommended that you take steps to improve your abilities before attempting the Police Entrance Evaluation. Take a careful look at any areas of weakness, as an overall pass depends on adequate performance in all tests in the evaluation. Remember, if you fail the Police Entrance Evaluation, you must wait six months before you can reapply.
